

## St Albans City Supporters Society Ltd – AGM 3.10.2018

### RESOLUTION

To change the current Saints City Trust objectives from:

- 1] To strengthen the bonds between St Albans City Football Club and the community which it serves and to represent the interests of the community in the running of the club.
- 2] To benefit present and future members of the community served by St Albans City Football Club by promoting, encouraging and furthering the game of football as a recreational facility, sporting activity and focus for community involvement.
- 3] To further the development of the game of football nationally and internationally and the upholding of its rules.
- 4] To encourage St Albans City Football Club to take proper account of the interests of its supporters and the community it serves in its decisions.
- 5] To encourage and promote the principle of supporter representation on the board of any company owning or controlling St Albans City Football Club and ultimately to be the vehicle for democratic elections to the board.
- 6] To promote, develop and respect the rights of members of the community served by St Albans City Football Club and people dealing with the society as set out in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union, having regard in particular to the need to provide information to members and conduct the affairs of the society in accessible and appropriate ways.
- 7] To support St Albans City Football Club and work towards its long term security and success.
- 8] To be a positive, open and broadly representative group, accessible and democratically run for all supporters of the club, regardless of their age, disability, gender orientation, race or religious beliefs.

### AND CHANGE TO

- 1] To strengthen the bonds between St Albans City Football Club and the community which it serves and to represent the interests of the community in the running of the club.
- 2] To assist St Albans City Football Club through the donation of funds, items or time to specific projects agreed by the Trust board.
- 3] To provide the supporters of St Albans City Football Club with a forum to discuss and influence the activities of the football club.
- 4] To encourage the residents of St Albans to support St Albans City their local Football Club by promoting the Club and Trust in the community.
- 5] To forge links with other organisations such as Supporters Trusts, Football Direct, Football Supporters Federation and to develop good relations with supporters of other football clubs.
- 6] To encourage and promote the principle of supporter representation on the board of any company owning or controlling St Albans City Football Club and potentially investing in shares if appropriate opportunities arise.
- 7] To be a positive, open and broadly representative group, accessible and democratically run for all supporters of the club, regardless of their age, disability, gender identity, sexual orientation, race or religious beliefs.

*This resolution must be passed by 80% of the members voting, and only comes into force if it is passed by that margin AND the numbers voting against do not equal more than 10% of those members eligible to vote.*
