### **Trust Annual General Meeting Wed 27 September 7:30pm In The Saints Bar**

The Trust will be shortly holding its AGM. It is a legal requirement that we have an AGM but most importantly, it gives members the opportunity to review the Trust's activities, question Board members and set the future direction of the Trust.

Members will receive papers about 2 weeks in advance of the meeting. These will include an agenda, the annual accounts, an annual report and any resolutions to be voted on. Members will be invited to submit any matters that they wish to be discussed before the meeting.

This year, the Trust's Board have agreed that the meeting will be asked to reaffirm that the accumulated funds of the Trust continue to be retained to be used to obtain a supporters' stake in the Football Club, if the opportunity were to arise. These funds, now amounting to around £14.5k, have been collected from subscriptions and donations since the inception of the Trust. Members have regularly agreed to this policy in the past but the Board felt it was opportune to discuss this again.
