



ANNUAL REPORT 2023

The Trust has continued to represent supporters' interests at the weekly Senior Leadership meetings held with club officials each Thursday. Amongst the issues raised over the last year are:

Stewarding, ticket pricing, quality of service at food and drink outlets on match days, ground lighting, cleanliness of toilets, and availability of programmes.

The latter part of the season was one of the busiest for some time when we arranged the end of season awards and away travel to the play off matches and for the final match, we transported 85 supporters to Oxford City. On this subject, we also ran transport to a number of games throughout the season, although disappointingly the take up rate has been low.

The installation of the Trust shed adjacent to the York Road entrance has given us a focal point in the ground and is gradually achieving recognition amongst supporters.

Our current and ongoing action plan focuses on:

Providing away travel, increasing awareness of the Trust via various means primarily via social media platforms, distribution flyers and a regular page in the match day programme.

We have also opened dialogue with the club on the Fair Game initiative.

As ever if any supporters, who have issues they wish to raise with the football club I encourage them to do so via the Trust.
