News coming out of the club has been slow of late but having attended a recent leadership meeting the following items should be in the public domain by now.

Season Tickets

I met with Andy Hippisley, the Club's Media Manager, to agree pricing for the coming season. Prices for season tickets along with match day admission prices will remain the same as last season. Additionally, a range of new ticketing initiatives will be available including a Next Generation ticket for 16-21 year old supporters. The Trust asked whether a discount was available on season tickets. It was explained that the previous discount was due to the interrupted season during the pandemic. The money raised from match day fundraising totalled £2,800, which was donated to the Football Club and will go towards the pitch room refurbishment.

Saints Bar Refurbishment

During the summer, work will take place to improve the furniture and layout of the bar. As part of this work, some of the photos currently on display will be available to supporters to at a minimal cost - more details to come.

Other News Items

Stadium naming rights - along with a number of clubs, Clarence Park will have a new name gained from a sponsorship deal and the final details are being worked out. I know that this is not a popular issue with supporters and I have asked for Clarence Park to be included as part of the name.

The Trust made a small contribution to the £12,000 raised by selling wristbands, which are still available from the Club Shop.
